## WHAT'S NEW in 2021?

- **Dates:** The Festival will be held in April/May (see dates below), having been postponed from 2020 due to COVID-19.
- **Quilt categories:** New for this year is the **Machine Embroidered** category, in which embroidery is the dominant design feature.  
Also, there will be no distinction between **large and small quilts** in any category at the point of entry. Some categories may be sub-divided by size after entries close. Please see the table of categories on Page 2.
- **Special awards:** Entrants will be able to identify the special awards for which they would like their entry considered. See Page 7 for details.
- **Monetary prizes:** All monetary prizes will be paid by electronic transfer to the winner's nominated account. No cheques will be issued.
- **Number of entries:** For the 2021 Festival, each entrant will be allowed a maximum of **eight** entries.

## ONLINE ENTRY FORM GUIDELINES

- All entries must be submitted via the online process. If this is a challenging prospect for you, please feel free to contact Ann Ewer on 0414 364 100 or Renée Amyot on 0403 159 990 for assistance.
- The on-line entry form is to be completed in accordance with the separate Conditions of Entry, Status Definitions and Categories information.
- A separate entry form is required for each quilt entered unless it is a linked pair or triptych. A maximum number of 5 entries per member includes Display Only entries.

### Paying for your entry

- The entry fee is \$15 per entry (non-refundable). This must be paid prior to completing your online entry and the receipt number noted. Payments may be made by direct deposit or at monthly Guild meetings. There is no entry fee for Junior entrants.

### Information you will need to have ready in order to complete your online entry form:

- Your contact details, including email address
- Your membership number or the membership number of your affiliated group
- For Junior entrants, name and membership number of their sponsor (a financial member of the Guild)
- For entries created by two or more people, details of the other entrant(s): name, membership number, status
- The category of your entry: refer to the flow chart and Table of Categories to make the most appropriate selection
- Specific details of the entry: the title of the entry and measurements in centimetres
- Any special award(s) for which you would like your entry considered (see Page 7 "Special Awards" for further details.
- The insurance value of your entry (see Condition of Entry No. 9 on Page 5)
- Payment details: reference number, receipt number from your financial institution, date of transaction
- Technical information: your design source, copyright permissions/acknowledgements, techniques and materials used (see Pages 9- 10 for further information)
- Personal narrative: a 40-50 word statement of interest to viewers, such as the purpose of this quilt, personal connections, choices/decisions made, particular challenges it presented
- A digital image of up to 5MB of your entry to be uploaded during the online entry process
- If you carry on a professional quilting enterprise in Australia, your ABN number.

### After you have submitted your online entry form:

- An automatic acknowledgment email will be sent shortly after the submit button is clicked. If you do not receive this email, **please check your junk mail folder before contacting foqentries@gmail.com**
- A record of all of the information you entered in the online form will be sent to you in a separate email; check this carefully for correctness.
