Online Entry Guide

Before starting the entry process, it may be helpful to gather and record the necessary details. Further information can be found in the online Festival of Quilts Handbook (<u>https://www.qgsa.org.au/links/</u>)

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- Quilt Card Information: This 600 character statement is the information that will be automatically printed on the quilt card attached to your quilt.

- o provide any necessary copyright acknowledgements
- provide details of your design or source pattern, designer, workshop, online class and any modifications that you have made
- o outline techniques and materials used
- for junior entrants, please indicate how much of the quilt making/quilting was completed by the mentor
- o proof read your statement for any errors
