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- Quilt Card Information: This 600 character statement is the information that will be automatically printed on the quilt card attached to your quilt.
 - limit of 600 characters (includes spaces and an automatic cut off will apply)

- Please do not use any abbreviations – they do not print out on the quilt cards
- be concise
- provide any necessary copyright acknowledgements
- provide details of your design or source - pattern, designer, workshop, online class and any modifications that you have made
- outline techniques and materials used
- it is essential that you **PROOF READ** your statement for any errors
- Junior Entrants will be emailed a Quilt Card proforma separately, seeking specific information about their quilt making journey.
